Environmental Superhero

- Gather the children on the carpet and explain that you have someone special to introduce to them.
- Slowly reveal the picture of the Caring Superhero. (Below)
- Ask the children:
 - Who do you think this might be?
 - Can you explain why you think that?
 - Does anyone have any other ideas?
- Point to the recycling symbol on the Caring Superhero's costume and ask the children if they know what the symbol stands for.
- If the children don't recognise the symbol, explain that it is a recycling symbol, which means turning old objects and materials into new and useful things.
- Explain that this is Caring Superhero and he is a very special superhero that helps to take care of our world in lots of different ways.
- Ask the children if they can tell you what a superhero does. Explain that it is someone with magical powers that can do amazing things.
- Tell the children that Caring Superhero is going to help us turn into superheroes! Explain to the children that firstly they are going to share their ideas about what they could do to help take care of their world, these will be their caring superpowers!
- Show the children the superhero costumes/props and explain that whenever they put the costume on they too will become a caring superhero! Explain that if you see them wearing the superhero costumes you would love to see them doing something caring for our world, for example, putting their rubbish in the recycling bin or picking up litter.
- You can use pillow covers as capes to help build up your costumes!
